A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND REDUCING THE COUNTY TRANSFER TAX FROM ONE PERCENT (1%) OF THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE FOR AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING TO SEVENTY FIVE ONE HUNDRETHS OF A PERCENT (0.75%) OF THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE FOR AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING BY AMENDING ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 144-20 (C) OF CHAPTER 144 ENTITLED "TAXATION" OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND REDUCING THE COUNTY TRANSFER TAX FROM ONE PERCENT (1%) OF THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE FOR AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING TO SEVENTY FIVE ONE HUNDRETHS OF A PERCENT (0.75%) OF THE CONSIDERATION PAYABLE FOR AN INSTRUMENT OF WRITING BY AMENDING ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 144-20 (C) OF CHAPTER 144 ENTITLED "TAXATION" OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE

SECTION ONE: Acting under Chapter 714 of the 1994 Laws of Maryland, now codified as Section 10-8.2 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (herein the "Acts") be it RESOLVED, ENACTED, and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County that Article VIII, Section 144-20 (C) of Chapter 144, entitled "Taxation" of the Dorchester County Code be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

County Transfer Tax

§144-20. Applicability.

(C) The County transfer tax imposed shall be SEVENTY FIVE ONE HUNDRETHS OF A percent (0.75%) of the consideration payable for an instrument of writing.

SECTION TWO: Be it further resolved by the County Council of Dorchester County that General Code Publishers is directed to codify new Section 144-20 (C) of Chapter 144 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester County accordingly.

SECTION THREE: Be it further resolved that this resolution shall be known as Resolution No. 2003- 4 of Dorchester County, Maryland and shall take effect on July 1, 2003.
