BILL NO. 2003- 7

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO AMEND SECTION 10-2 OF ARTICLE 10 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN REELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER OR AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION IN SEPTEMBER OF AN ELECTION YEAR MAY NOT CONTINUE TO INCUR EXPENSES AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER.

Introduced, read first time, ordered posted on official bulletin board of County, County Office Building, 501 Court Lane, Cambridge, Maryland 21613.

Ordered publication for once a week for two successive weeks, and public hearing scheduled on Tuesday, May 6th, 2003, Room 110, County Office Building, 501 Court Lane, Cambridge, Maryland at 7:20 p.m.

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO AMEND SECTION 10-2 OF ARTICLE 10 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN REELECTED AT THE GENERAL ELECTION IN NOVEMBER OR AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION IN SEPTEMBER OF AN ELECTION YEAR MAY NOT CONTINUE TO INCUR EXPENSES AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER.

SECTION ONE: Acting under Article 25A. Section 5 (A) (1) and Section 5 (S) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and Article 2, Section 207 of the Charter for Dorchester County (the "Acts") be it ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland, in legislative session, that Section 10-2 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland entitled "Commissioners" be amended to add the following:

§10-2. Compensation.

A County Council member who is not reelected at a November General Election or a September Primary Election may not be reimbursed by the County for expenses incurred during the time immediately following the election and before the newly elected County Council takes their oath of office without prior written approval from the Dorchester County Manager.

SECTION TWO: BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY that General Code Publishers is directed to codify amended Section 10-2 of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland in the Dorchester County Code accordingly.

SECTION THREE: BE IT FURTHER ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2003- 7 of Dorchester County, Maryland, and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage.
