AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(S) AND ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(T) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION 82-12(B) OF CHAPTER 82 ENTITLED "ELECTRICAL STANDARDS" OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE, PROVIDING THAT AN ELECTRICIAN GENERAL IS ANY PERSON ENGAGED ONLY IN HOUSE WIRING LIMITED TO A DWELLING CONTAINING NO MORE THAN FOUR FAMILY UNITS, AND COMMERCIAL WIRING LIMITED TO CIRCUITS OF NOT MORE THAN SIXTY (60) AMPERES, THREE PHASE IN AN EXISTING COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE.

BILL NO. 2009 - 9

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(S) AND ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(T) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND REPEALING AND REENACTING SECTION 82-12(B) OF CHAPTER 82 ENTITLED "ELECTRICAL STANDARDS" OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE, PROVIDING THAT AN ELECTRICIAN GENERAL IS ANY PERSON ENGAGED ONLY IN HOUSE WIRING LIMITED TO A DWELLING CONTAINING NO MORE THAN FOUR FAMILY UNITS, AND COMMERCIAL WIRING LIMITED TO CIRCUITS OF NOT MORE THAN SIXTY (60) AMPERES, THREE PHASE IN AN EXISTING COMMERCIAL STRUCTURE.

SECTION ONE: Acting under Article 25A, Section 5(T) and Section 5(S) of The Annotated Code of Maryland (the "Acts"), be it ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that Section 82-12(B) of Chapter 82, entitled "Electrical Standards" of the Dorchester County Code be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

ELECTRICAL STANDARDS

CHAPTER 82

§ 82.12 Applications for registration.

B. Electrician general:

Any person engaged only in house wiring limited to a dwelling containing no more than four family units, and commercial wiring limited to circuits of not more than sixty (60) amperes, three phase in an existing commercial structure.

SECTION TWO: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that General Code Publishers is directed to codify new Section 82-12(B) of Chapter 82 of the Dorchester County Code accordingly.

SECTION THREE: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2009-9 of Dorchester County, Maryland and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage.

SECTION FOUR: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED that a fair summary of this Bill be published once after enactment in at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation in Dorchester County, Maryland.
