AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND
PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(S) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF

AREA IN SECTION 116-3 OF CHAPTER 116 OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE

BILL NO. 2012- 4

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 25A, SECTION 5(S) OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND REPEALING AND REENACTING THE DEFINITION OF RESIDENTIAL AREA IN SECTION 116-3 OF CHAPTER 116 OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY CODE ENTITLED NUISANCE CONTROL.

SECTION ONE: Acting under Article 25A and Section 5(S) of The Annotated Code of Maryland (the "Acts"), be it ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that the definition of "Residential Area" as set forth in Section 116-3 of Chapter 116 of the Dorchester County Code be repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

§116-3. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

RESIDENTIAL AREA – An area having an average of two (2) acres or less per dwelling unit.

SECTION TWO: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that General Code Publishers is directed to codify amended Section 116-3 of Chapter 116 in the Dorchester County Code accordingly.

SECTION THREE: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2012- 4 of Dorchester County, Maryland and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage.
