

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND PURSUANT TO SECTION 21-706.1(C) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND ADDING NEW CHAPTER 132 ENTITLED "SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS", WHICH AUTHORIZES THE USE OF SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND.

BILL NO. 2013 - 3

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND PURSUANT TO SECTION 21-706.1(C) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND ADDING NEW CHAPTER 132 ENTITLED "SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS", WHICH AUTHORIZES THE USE OF SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENTS

The 2011 Maryland General Assembly passed Senate Bill 679 (Chapter 273, Acts 2011) authorizing the use of school bus monitoring cameras, effective October 1, 2011, (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), which is codified in Section 21-706.1 of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

The Act authorizes the Dorchester County Sheriff's Office, in consultation with the County Board of Education, to place monitoring cameras on county school buses.

The purpose of school bus monitoring cameras is to record a motor vehicle committing a violation related to overtaking and passing a school vehicle.

The County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland is the governing body of Dorchester County and desires to authorize the use of a school bus monitoring camera to the full extent provided in the Md. Annotated Code, Transportation Article, §21-706.1(c)(1).

SECTION ONE: Acting under the Act, be it ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that new Chapter 132 entitled "School Bus Monitoring Cameras" be enacted to the Dorchester County Code to read as follows:

CHAPTER 132

SCHOOL BUS MONITORING CAMERAS

§132-1. Use of School Bus Monitoring Cameras.

A. The County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland, as the governing body of Dorchester County, authorizes the use of school bus monitoring cameras.

B. The purpose of this Chapter is to authorize all uses to the full extent provided in Maryland Annotated Code, Transportation Article, §10-706(c)(1).

C. The terms used in this Chapter have the same meaning as the corresponding terms used or defined in Md. Annotated Code, Transportation Article, §21-706.1.

SECTION TWO: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that General Code Publishers is directed to codify new Chapter 132 of the Dorchester County Code accordingly.

SECTION THREE: Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2013- 3 of Dorchester County, Maryland and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage.
