
BILL NO. 2014- 4

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 10-2(C) OF ARTICLE 10 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LAWS OF MARYLAND TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN REELECTED AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION OF AN ELECTION YEAR MAY NOT CONTINUE TO INCUR EXPENSES AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL AFTER SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> OF SUCH ELECTION YEAR WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER AND TO PROVIDE THAT A COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBER WHO IS NOT REELECTED AT A NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION MAY NOT BE REIMBURSED BY THE COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THE TIME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE GENERAL ELECTION AND BEFORE THE NEWLY ELECTED COUNTY COUNCIL TAKES ITS OATH OF OFFICE WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER.

AN ACT OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO REPEAL AND REENACT SECTION 10-2(C) OF ARTICLE 10 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LAWS OF MARYLAND TO PROVIDE THAT COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBERS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN REELECTED AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION OF AN ELECTION YEAR MAY NOT CONTINUE TO INCUR EXPENSES AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL AFTER SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> OF SUCH ELECTION YEAR WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER AND TO PROVIDE THAT A COUNTY COUNCIL MEMBER WHO IS NOT REELECTED AT A NOVEMBER GENERAL ELECTION MAY NOT BE REIMBURSED BY THE COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED DURING THE TIME IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE GENERAL ELECTION AND BEFORE THE NEWLY ELECTED COUNTY COUNCIL TAKES ITS OATH OF OFFICE WITHOUT PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE DORCHESTER COUNTY MANAGER.

SECTION ONE: Acting under Section 10-206 of the Local Government Article, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (the "Act") be it ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that Section 10-2(c) of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, be, and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

§ 10-2. Compensation.

C (1). A County Council member who is not reelected at the Primary Election may not be reimbursed by the County for expenses incurred after September 1<sup>st</sup> of such election year without prior written approval from the Dorchester County Manager.

(2). A County Council member who is not reelected at a November General Election may not be reimbursed by the County for expenses incurred during the time immediately following the general election and before the newly elected County Council takes its oath of office without prior written approval from the Dorchester County Manager.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to the Act be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that General Code Publishers is directed to codify new Section 10-2(c) of Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland in the Dorchester County Code accordingly.

**SECTION THREE:** Be it further ENACTED and ORDAINED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that this Bill shall be known as Bill No. 2014- 4 of Dorchester County, Maryland and shall take effect sixty (60) days after its final passage.


