

RESOLUTION NO. 360

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, Dorchester County adopted a Stormwater Management Ordinance designated as Ordinance Number 296 pursuant to the Environment Article, Title 4, Subtitle 2, Annotated Code of Maryland (formerly, the Natural Resources Article, Title 8, Subtitle 11 A) on July 10, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the following Towns have reviewed the County's ordinance and believe that it is satisfactory to protect the lives and the property of Town residents: Church Creek, Hurlock, East New Market, Galestown, Brookview, Eldorado, Vienna, and Secretary; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of these Towns have adopted or will adopt the County's ordinance and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County is willing to administer and enforce the Stormwater Management Ordinance within the corporate limits of these Towns.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, Dorchester County shall administer and enforce the provisions of said Stormwater Management Ordinance within the corporate limits of the Towns of Church Creek, Hurlock, East New Market, Galestown, Brookview, Eldorado, Vienna and Secretary.
