

RESOLUTION NO. 369

A RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF THE COUNTY DOG CONTROL ORDINANCE IN DORCHESTER COUNTY EFFECTIVE AUGUST 13, 2003

WHEREAS, the Dorchester County Council recognized that the Dorchester County Humane Society advised the County Council that it would be unable to provide dog control services in Dorchester County for Fiscal Year 2003/2004 based on proposed funding of \$123,840;

WHEREAS, the enforcement provisions of Chapter 78 of the Dorchester County Code were suspended effective May 6, 2003 pending possible repeal of Chapter 78 by the Dorchester County Council; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2003, the Dorchester County Council accepted a proposal from Steve Williams, Public Safety Director, to establish a Dog Control Division of the Public Safety Department; and

WHEREAS, the Dog Control Division of the Public Safety Department will be responsible for the enforcement of Chapter 78 of the Dorchester County Code pending the enactment of legislation to amend Chapter 78.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the County Council of Dorchester County has agreed to reinstate effective August 13, 2003 Chapter 78 of the Dorchester County Code.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
