

Resolution No. 375

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH INCREASED USER FEES FOR THE 911 EMERGENCY NUMBER SYSTEM IN DORCHESTER COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Laws of the State of Maryland, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland, is authorized and empowered to adopt a charge for the local 911 emergency number system;

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland has now determined that it would be in the best interest of the people served by the 911 emergency number system and the people in Dorchester County, Maryland to increase the local charge as authorized by Maryland Legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland that:

1. An increase in the 911 fees from fifty cents (\$0.50) per month to seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per month, in addition to any state levy, is hereby imposed upon all current bills rendered for wired and wireless service within Dorchester County.
2. The County Manager shall forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the 911 Coordinator of the Maryland Emergency Numbers Systems Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect on October 1, 2003.
