

RESOLUTION NO. 408

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH LANDFILL TIPPING FEE CREDITS FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, Dorchester County desires to assist municipalities and communities located within the County with community cleanup and other public improvement efforts; and

WHEREAS, a landfill tipping fee credit to each of the incorporated municipalities located within the County can be established for the use of municipalities during the period from March 30, 2005 through June 30, 2005;

WHEREAS, a landfill tipping fee credit to communities in the County which are not located within incorporated municipalities can be established on a case-by-case basis;

WHEREAS, municipalities and communities who are granted landfill tipping fee credits will be required to comply with the attached Rules and Regulations established by the Dorchester County Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, a landfill tipping fee credit of \$500 is hereby established for each of the following incorporated municipalities for the stated period for the purpose of municipal disposal of trash and debris related to community cleanup and other public improvement efforts. The municipality will agree to set disposal criteria for the cleanup effort, assume costs associated with the placement and removal of refuse containers, and schedule in advance with Landfill staff the disposal of refuse collected as a result of municipal cleanup efforts. The total credit granted shall be \$4,500.

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Dorchester County Council agrees to consider requests for landfill credits from communities which are not located within incorporated municipalities for projects associated with community cleanup and public improvement efforts not to exceed \$500 per request. The approved community will be responsible to insure that adequate disposal facilities are available and will be responsible for all costs associated with the placement and removal of refuse containers. The approved community will also be responsible to schedule disposal of refuse collected as a result of community cleanup projects in advance with Landfill staff. Total community requests not to exceed \$4,500 will be approved on a first come, first served basis.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
