A resolution of the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland amending the 2004 Dorchester County Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan by changing the designation of an area of land located south of Maryland Route 343, and shown on Tax Map 30, Parcels 19, 20, 82, and 93. Said land area having been annexed into the City of Cambridge and currently designated as a planned service area W-3 and S-3, to be amended and changed to W-1 and S-1 which means existing service or planned service within a 2 year period.

Whereas, Maryland State law mandates that all Maryland Counties adopt a Comprehensive Water and Sewer Master Plan; and

Whereas, Dorchester County, Maryland has adopted its most recent and current Water and Sewer Plan on March 16, 2004; and

Whereas, a request was filed to amend the Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan for certain properties located on the south side of the City of Cambridge and identified on the attached exhibits as "Proposed Amendment to Cambridge and Vicinity Comprehensive Water Service Plan" and "Proposed Amendment to Cambridge and Vicinity Comprehensive Sewer Service Plan"; and


Whereas, the Dorchester County Planning Commission reviewed the application and determined that this amendment is consistent with the Dorchester County Comprehensive Plan; and

Whereas, the County Council of Dorchester County, having held a public hearing regarding this matter on January 17, 2006, and having given careful consideration to the request, voted unanimously to amend the adopted Comprehensive Water and Sewer Plan.




