

RESOLUTION FOR THE COUNTY COUNCIL TO WITHDRAW THE SWORN DEPUTIES OF THE DORCHESTER COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S AND TEACHER'S RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEMS AND TRANSFER THOSE SWORN DEPUTIES TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS PENSION SYSTEM (LEOPS) OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND RETIREMENT AND PENSION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, legislation was enacted enabling participating governmental units to enroll their law enforcement officers in the Law Enforcement Officers Pension System on or after July 1, 1999;

WHEREAS, a preliminary valuation has determined that transferable assets exist in the current pension system that will provide an annual credit toward the cost of the Law Enforcement Officers Pension System (LEOPS) for the next ten (10) years;

WHEREAS, a poll of the sworn deputies of the Dorchester County Sheriff's Department has determined that at least one hundred percent (100 %) percent of the sworn deputies desire to transfer to the Law Enforcement Officers Pension System (LEOPS) and this is in excess of the sixty percent (60%) required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Dorchester County Council, that the sworn deputies of the Dorchester County Sheriff's Department be withdrawn from the Employee's and Teacher's Retirement and Pension Systems on June 30, 2007 and be transferred to the Law Enforcement Officers Pension System (LEOPS) of the State of Maryland Retirement and Pension System on July 1, 2007.

THIS RESOLUTION IS HEREBY PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS 8th DAY OF MAY 2007 TO BE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007.
