A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND AMENDING THE 1996 DORCHESTER COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 66B, ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND.

WHEREAS, Maryland State Law, Article 66B, Annotated Code of Maryland, mandates all Maryland Counties to adopt Comprehensive Plans, and empowers Dorchester County to adopt and amend a Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, The County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland has adopted its most recent and current Comprehensive Plan on September 24, 1996, by Resolution Number 241; and

WHEREAS, The County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland finds it necessary and desirable to update certain elements of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Dorchester County Planning Commission held a public hearing on May 7, 2008, where they reviewed the application and determined that this amendment is consistent with the Dorchester County Comprehensive Plan, and thus unanimously recommended the proposed amendment to the County Council for adoption; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland having held an advertised public hearing regarding this matter on June 17, 2008, and having given careful consideration to the request for the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland having complied with the procedural and substantive prerequisites of Article 66B, Annotated Code of Maryland, does hereby adopt the attached amendment(s) and incorporate them into the adopted Comprehensive Plan for Dorchester County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a true and exact copy of the Comprehensive Plan amendment(s) shall be certified to the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Dorchester County.
