

RESOLUTION NO. 453

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND TO SUPPORT A PROJECT TO EXPAND THE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM AT NEW BEGINNINGS YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES AT BAY COUNTRY APARTMENTS AND PARKSIDE VILLAGE APARTMENTS ON GREENWOOD AVENUE, CAMBRIDGE, MARYLAND BEYOND THE TRADITIONAL AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAMS TO DEVELOP THE TEEN AMBASSADOR PROGRAM. THIS INITIATIVE WILL FOCUS ON TEEN ISSUES. IT WILL GIVE THEM AN OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP LEADERSHIP SKILLS, TO ENCOURAGE DREAMS TO ACHIEVE A COLLEGE EDUCATION AND GREATER ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY AND TO PROVIDE RESOURCES TO PREVENT NEGATIVE BEHAVIORS I.E. DRUG, ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, VIOLENCE AND GANG ACTIVITY. THIS PROGRAM WILL BE IMPLEMENTED WITH ADDITIONAL STAFF, UPGRADED EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS FOR PROGRAMS SUPPORTED BY THE CITC FUNDS. THERE IS CONTINUED SUPPORT FROM MANY COMMUNITY GROUPS.


WHEREAS, New Beginnings Youth and Family Services, a non-profit organization proposes to undertake the project described above; and

WHEREAS, New Beginnings Youth and Family Services has applied to the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland for approval of the project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the Project, under the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, we, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland, by virtue of this resolution, do hereby express support of the Project, as described above.


