

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND, PURSUANT TO SECTION 17-1003 OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND DESIGNATING THE PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT UNIT TO RECEIVE RECORDS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 17-1011 (B) OF THE BUSINESS REGULATION ARTICLE.

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, § 17-1006 requires certain individuals doing business as a junk dealer or scrap metal processor in the state of Maryland be licensed to engage in said business and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article, § 17-1003 requires that a county or municipal governing body in the county in which the license of the junk dealer or scrap metal processor is held shall designate by resolution the primary law enforcement unit to receive records in accordance with the statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion made, duly seconded and carried, it is this 22 day of June, 2010, RESOLVED by the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland, as follows:

1. That the Maryland State Police, Easton Barracks, is hereby designated as the Primary Law Enforcement Unit for Dorchester County in regards to the enforcement of the regulations as set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article § 17-1001 et al;
2. That the Maryland State Police, Easton Barracks, shall receive records in accordance with § 17-1011(b) of the Annotated Code of Maryland, Business Regulations Article.




