

RESOLUTION NO. 519

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY TO AMEND RESOLUTION 454 WHICH CREATED A TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE TO ESTABLISH THE PROCEDURE FOR REFERRING ITEMS TO THE COMMITTEE FOR REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County executed Resolution No. 454 on September 9, 2008 establishing the Traffic Safety Committee; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County wishes to amend Resolution No. 454 to establish a procedure for referring items to the Traffic Safety Committee for its review and recommendation to the County Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the County Council of Dorchester County, does hereby amend Resolution No. 454 to incorporate the policy the Council agreed to establish relating to the Traffic Safety Committee's role at its March 20, 2012 meeting:

- a. There is hereby created a Traffic Safety Committee.
- b. The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of four members from the following: Sheriff, Public Works Director or assigned Division Heads as assigned by the County Manager or Public Safety Director or assigned Division Heads as assigned by the County Manager and one representative from the County Council.
- c. The role of the Traffic Safety Committee is to address issues that arise regarding County roads including but not limited to changing speed limit signs and placement of traffic signs.
- d. A constituent or requestor must provide a written request to the County Council, which will consider the request in an open meeting, and will, by formal action, refer the written request to the Traffic Safety Committee should it relate to a traffic safety matter that the County Council feels the Committee should review.
- e. The Traffic Safety Committee will provide advice and recommendations to the County Council but will not be a decision/policy making group.
- f. The Traffic Safety Committee will only meet on items referred by the County Council, but will meet no more than once a month unless specifically requested to do so and will forward Minutes/proceedings of each meeting to the County Council for their information.
- g. The Board shall annually select a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary from the membership and shall adopt rules of procedure in order to conduct meetings.
- h. Staff will continue to advertise Traffic Safety Committee meetings under the Open Meetings Act and such advertisements will include a
