

**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF THE
JOINT APPLICATION OF DELMARVA COMMUNITY SERVICES
AND HABITAT FOR HUMANITY CHOPTANK TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD
CONSERVATION INITIATIVE PROGRAM FOR FUNDS TO ACQUIRE
AND REHABILITATE HOUSES FOR RESALE AND BLIGHTED
OR ABANDONED PROPERTIES FOR NEW HOUSING**

WHEREAS, State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Neighborhood Conservation Initiative (NCI) Program; and

WHEREAS, Delmarva Community Services and Habitat for Humanity Choptank are eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland NCI program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development and intend to submit an application for a minimum of \$500,000 to be used for acquisition and rehabilitation of houses for resale to eligible persons; and acquisition and redevelopment of blighted or abandoned properties to be used for new housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland expresses support of the Project, as described above and recognizes that Delmarva Community Services and Habitat for Humanity Choptank target Neighborhood Conservation Area in Dorchester County by zip code: Cambridge/21613, prioritizing the City's Maple Street district.




