A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT APPLICATION TO THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT (DBED) FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDESIGNATION OF THE CAMBRIDGE ARTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICT

BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council of Dorchester County as follows:

WHEREAS, the Arts and Entertainment District is a geographically designated area in which a high concentration of arts and entertainment facilities serve as an anchor attraction; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the Arts and Entertainment District is to stimulate neighborhood revitalization , improve the attractiveness and safety of areas, stimulate business activity, attract visitors and residents, and build the tax base; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cambridge has applied to the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development for approval of REDESIGNATION of the Arts and Entertainment District; and

WHEREAS, the County Council supports the submission of application to DBED requesting the REDESIGNATION of the Arts and Entertainment District as depicted on the attached map, by the City of Cambridge


