

RESOLUTION NO. 540

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION OF CHANNEL MARKER FOUNDATION, INC. FROM THE MARYLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FUNDS TO REPAIR OLD ROOFS AND TO REMODEL AND IMPROVE THE KITCHENS IN ITS HOMES LOCATED AT 503 AND 505 ACADEMY STREET

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, Channel Marker Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit organization that provides mental health support services to some of the community's most vulnerable citizens and has served Dorchester, Caroline and Talbot Counties since 1982; and

WHEREAS, the two residences on Academy Street are home to 11 clients that fall in the very low to low income range and require intensive level support; and

WHEREAS, Channel Marker Foundation, Inc. is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland CDBG program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development and intends to submit an application for \$60,000 to be used to replace the aging roofs and to upgrade and improve the kitchens in its homes located at 503 and 505 Academy Street in Cambridge, Maryland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland expresses support of the Project, as described above.




