

**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY FROM THE MARYLAND NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAM FOR FUNDS TO SUPPORT STRATEGIC DEMOLITION OF COUNTY OWNED HOUSES IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Neighborhood Revitalization (NI) Program, Strategic Demolition & Smart Growth Impact Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, Dorchester County is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland SDSGIF program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Council of Dorchester County recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the communities in Dorchester County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Department, either through Community Legacy or through other Programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other State departments or agencies, may provide some or all of the financing for the Project (the "Project Financing") in order to assist in making it financially feasible; and

**WHEREAS**, the Project is located within a priority funding area under Section 5-7B-02 of the Smart Growth Act and the Project will conform to the local zoning code; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the County Council of Dorchester County authorize the submittal of an application for SDSGIF Grant funds in the amount of \$105,000 this 7<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2015;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Ricky C. Travers, Council President, is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of the application.




