**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF A REQUEST OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY TO THE MARYLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FUNDS FOR DELMARVA COMMUNITY SERVICES CHESAPEAKE GROVE INTERGENERATIONAL CENTER ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN OF BUILDING IN CAMBRIDGE, MARYLAND**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Ricky C. Travers, Council President, is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of the application.


