A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY TO CHANGE THE PROCEDURE FOR REFERRING ITEMS TO THE TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE AND TO REMOVE A REQUIREMENT RELATING TO MINUTES/PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County executed Resolution No. 454 on September 9, 2008 establishing the Traffic Safety Committee; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County executed Resolution 519 to establish a procedure for referring items to the Traffic Safety Committee for its review and recommendation to the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County wishes to amend Resolution No. 519 to revise the referral procedure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the County Council of Dorchester County, does hereby amend Resolution No. 519 as follows:


- a. There is hereby created a Traffic Safety Committee.
- b. The Traffic Safety Committee shall consist of four members from the following: Sheriff, Public Works Director or assigned Division Heads as assigned by the County Manager and one representative from the County Council.
- c. The role of the Traffic Safety Committee is to address issues that arise regarding County roads including but not limited to changing speed limit signs and placement of traffic signs.
- d. A constituent or requestor must provide a written request addressed to the County Council, which the County Council or County Manager will review and provide the written request to the Traffic Safety Committee should it relate to a traffic safety matter that is under the County Council's purview.
- e. The Traffic Safety Committee will provide advice and recommendations to the County Council but will not be a decision/policy making group.
- f. The Traffic Safety Committee will only meet on items referred by either the County Council or County Manager, but will meet no more than once a month, unless specifically requested to do so.
- g. The Board shall annually select a Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary from the membership and shall adopt rules of procedure in order to conduct meetings.

- h. Staff will continue to advertise Traffic Safety Committee meetings under the Open Meetings Act and such advertisements will include a list of agenda items in a local news publication, bulletin board postings, and on the County's website.




