**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 449 TO CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF THE LANDFILL TIPPING FEE CREDIT FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND COMMUNITIES**

DORCHESTER COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, Dorchester County desires to assist municipalities and communities located within in the County with community cleanup and other public improvement efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland adopted Resolution No. 449 which established a landfill tipping fee Credit for each of the incorporated municipalities located within the County for the use of municipalities during the fiscal year of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 and each succeeding fiscal year.

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 449 also established a landfill tipping fee credit to communities in the County which are not located within incorporated municipalities on a case-by-case basis during the fiscal year of during the fiscal year of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 and each succeeding fiscal year;

**WHEREAS**, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland wishes to increase the landfill tipping fee credit for the municipalities and communities as referenced above;

**WHEREAS**, municipalities and communities who are granted landfill tipping fee credits will be required to comply with the attached Rules and Regulations established by the Dorchester County Council;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the landfill tipping fee credit established for each of the below incorporated municipalities for the stated purpose of municipal disposal of trash and debris related to community cleanup and other public improvement efforts is changed to \$750. The municipality will agree to set disposal criteria for the cleanup effort, assume costs associated with the placement and removal of refuse containers, and schedule in advance with Landfill staff the disposal of refuse collected as a result of municipal cleanup efforts. The total credit granted shall be \$6,750.

**NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Dorchester County Council agrees to consider requests for landfill credits from communities which are not located within incorporated municipalities for projects associated with community cleanup and public improvement efforts not to exceed \$750 per request. The approved community will be responsible to insure that adequate disposal facilities are available and will be responsible for all costs associated with the placement and removal of refuse containers. The approved community will also be responsible

to schedule disposal of refuse collected as a result of community cleanup projects in advance with Landfill staff. Total community requests not to exceed \$6,750 will be approved on a first come, first served basis.

THIS RESOLUTION, shall take effect immediately upon its passage.





**RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING LANDFILL TIPPING FEE  
CREDITS FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND COMMUNITIES**

1. No commercial businesses; intended for residential/roadside cleanup only
2. Prior notification must be provided to the landfill staff in order to appropriately schedule the cleanup event
3. All trash and debris must cross County scales
4. All trash and debris must be collected in 30 yard dumpsters or one 40 yard dumpster; no more than two 30 yard dumpsters or one 40 yard dumpster per tipping fee credit will be accepted. Any municipality wishing to deposit trash and debris may bring the trash into the Landfill in a municipality-owned vehicle if they choose to do so.
5. Exceptions: refrigerators; air conditioners; all tires; hazardous waste; automobiles; boats; trailers; and mobile homes.
