

RESOLUTION NO. 597

A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY TO THE MARYLAND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FUNDS FOR RENOVATIONS AND REPAIRS TO BATHROOMS IN THE COUNTY OFFICE AND COURT HOUSE BUILDINGS IN CAMBRIDGE, MARYLAND

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland through the Department of Housing and Community Development has solicited applications from eligible jurisdictions to apply for funding under the Maryland Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County is eligible to apply for funds from the Maryland CDBG program through the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County have held the required public hearing related to the formulation of Dorchester County's Block Grant Application; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County understand and acknowledge that they would be responsible for completion of grant activities and any corrective actions including the repayment of funds if necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council of Dorchester County authorize the submittal of an application for Community Development Block Grant funds in the amount of \$300,000 this 16th day of May, 2017 for the following project(s):

For architectural services and to Renovate and Upgrade the 4 bathrooms, including updated ADA compliance requirements, in the Dorchester County Office Building located at 501 Court Lane, Cambridge, Maryland and the bathroom at the Clerk of the Court's Office in the Court House Building located at 206 High Street, Cambridge, Maryland.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Ricky C. Travers, Council President, is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the submission of the application.


