**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DORCHESTER COUNTY,
MARYLAND ADOPTING THE 2017 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland recognizes the federal Disaster Act of 2000 requiring that all States and local jurisdictions develop, submit and update hazard mitigation plans that may reduce the impact of hazards; and


WHEREAS, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future federal funding for hazard mitigation projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland hereby adopts the 2017 Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Dorchester County Emergency Services is authorized to submit the adopted 2017 Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.


