

RESOLUTION NO. 648

RESOLUTION TO RECLASSIFY THE LOCAL MANAGEMENT BOARD
(ALSO KNOWN AS COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP FOR CHILDREN, YOUTH & FAMILIES)

WHEREAS, the Dorchester County Commissioners, by Resolution No. 255 dated April 29, 1997, established a Local Management Board for Youth and Family Services as a public agency that has operated as an instrument of County Government;

WHEREAS, Resolution Nos. 279, 349 and 478 previously provided clarification to Resolution No. 255; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the requirement of the Maryland Code for Human Services Section 8-301. Local management boards, requiring that each county establish and maintain a local management board certain clarifications are necessary;

WHEREAS, on or about June, 21, 2022 the Dorchester County Council reclassified the Local Management Board as a quasi-public non-profit corporation that is not an instrument of county government and designated Moving Dorchester Forward as the Local Management Board for Dorchester County;

WHEREAS, on or about July 1, 2022 the Dorchester County Council will enter into the Community Partnership Agreement between the State, the County and Moving Dorchester Forward (as the Local Management Board) for Moving Dorchester Forward to implement interagency delivery systems for children, youth and families for Dorchester County.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Dorchester County Council that the Local Management Board will be reclassified as a quasi-public nonprofit corporation that is not an instrument of county government and designates Moving Dorchester Forward, Inc. as the Local Management Board for Dorchester County pursuant to Title 8 of the Human Services Article of the Maryland Annotated Code effective effective July 1, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION shall take effect immediately upon its passage and void all previous resolutions).
