

RESOLUTION NO. 649

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 499 AND
RESOLUTION NO. 581 TO CHANGE THE AMOUNT OF THE LANDFILL
TIPPING FEE CREDIT FOR MUNICIPALITIES AND COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, Dorchester County desires to assist municipalities and communities located within in the County with community cleanup and other public improvement efforts; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland adopted Resolution No. 449 which established a landfill tipping fee Credit for each of the incorporated municipalities located within the County for the use of municipalities during the fiscal year of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 and each succeeding fiscal year.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 449 also established a landfill tipping fee credit to communities in the County which are not located within incorporated municipalities on a case-by-case basis during the fiscal year of during the fiscal year of July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008 and each succeeding fiscal year;

WHEREAS, the County Council of Dorchester County, Maryland wishes to increase the landfill tipping fee credit for the municipalities and communities as referenced above;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 581 passed on April 5, 2016 increased the landfill tipping fee credit to \$750.00 for each of the incorporated municipalities located within the County and \$750.00 to communities in the County which are not located within incorporated municipalities on a case-by-case basis.

WHEREAS, municipalities and communities who are granted landfill tipping fee credits will be required to comply with the attached Rules and Regulations established by the Dorchester County Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, the landfill tipping fee credit established for each of the below incorporated municipalities for the stated purpose of municipal disposal of trash and debris related to community cleanup and other public improvement efforts is changed to \$1,000. The municipality will agree to set disposal criteria for the cleanup effort, assume costs associated with the placement and removal of refuse containers, and schedule in advance with Landfill staff the disposal of refuse collected as a result of municipal cleanup efforts. The total credit granted shall be \$9,000.
