

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2022 DORCHESTER COUNTY ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Dorchester County Council recognizes the Federal Disaster Act of 2000 requiring that all States and local jurisdictions develop, submit, and update hazard mitigation plans that may reduce the impacts of hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future Federal funding for hazard mitigation projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dorchester County Council's participation in the planning process along with other units of local government within the County to prepare the 2022 Dorchester County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Dorchester County Council hereby adopts the 2022 Dorchester County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Dorchester County Department of Emergency Services is authorized to submit on behalf of the participating municipalities the adopted 2022 Dorchester County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for final review and approval.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that George L. Pfeffer, Jr., President, is authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents required for the adoption of this plan.


